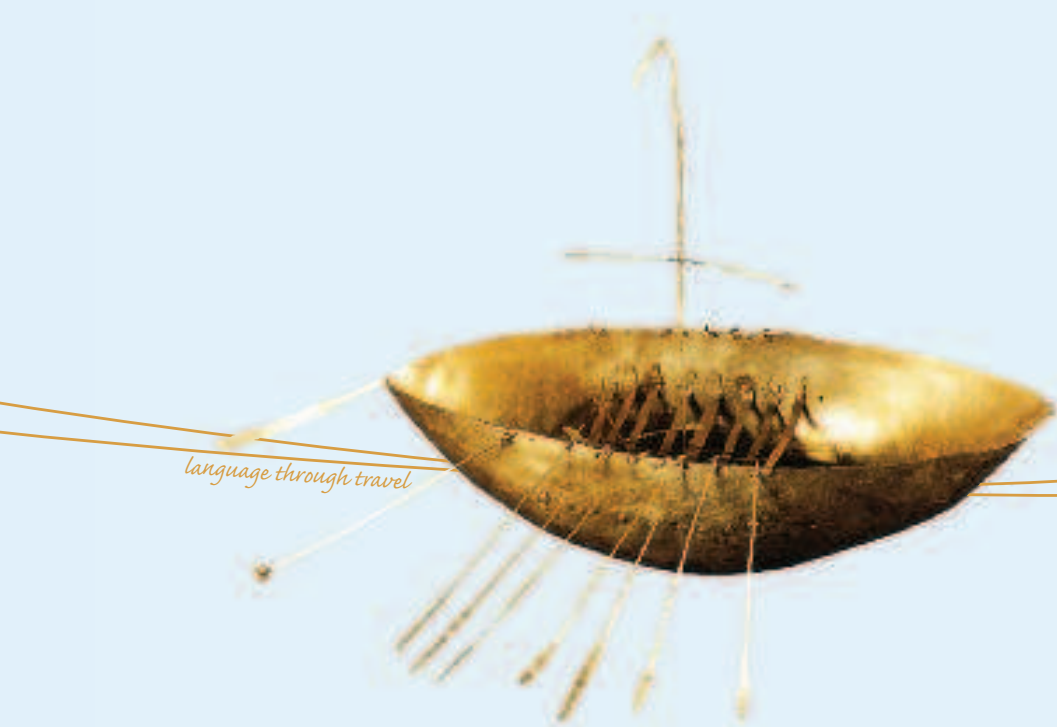

Terms & Conditions for Junior Summer Programmes 2012 – DUBLIN

1. Age

Junior Programmes available for students aged 11-17 years old

2. Classes

Each class hour is 60 minutes. There are 15 lessons per week.

3. Fees

Package fees include:

- 15 hours tuition in mixed nationality classes
- Full-board host family or residential accommodation
- Hot lunch at school in Homestay Centre
- Private daily transport to and from the school
- Afternoon activities Monday-Friday and 1 disco per week in Homestay Centre
- Afternoon and evening activities every day in Residential Centre
- 1 full day excursion per week
- All course materials, placement test and end of course certificate

Package Fees do not include:

- Private insurance, bank charges or airport transfers

4. Accommodation

Homestay Programme Sutton Park School

Accommodation is in a twin room, shared with another student of a different nationality

Residential Programme Deer Park Resort

Accommodation is in large shared bedrooms with 3-4 students. All rooms have a TV, lounge area and private bathroom.

5. Airport Transfers

All junior students must book return airport transfers with IH Dublin. Transfers outside of the hours 08.00 – 22.00 will be subject to a supplement of €30 per transfer.

If you are being accompanied by an adult/guardian from the airport and do not require an airport transfer, please notify us in advance of your arrival time.

6. Public Holidays

August 6th is a public holiday in Ireland

Please note that: No lessons take place on August 6th and a full-day excursion is organised. Classes for that week start on Tuesday August 7th.

7. Insurance

Students are advised to take out private medical and travel insurance. All EU nationals should also bring a European Health Insurance Card which covers public medical care.

8. Visas

Non EU nationals should contact their local Irish Embassy or Consulate or visit the Department of Justice website www.justice.ie for details of visa requirements. IH Dublin offers an efficient visa support service.

9. Cancellation

- If a course is cancelled more than 14 days before the start date, a registration fee of €50 will be charged
- If a course is cancelled less than 14 days before the start date, one week's programme will be charged (divide 2 week course price by 2 to obtain 1 week price)
- No refunds can be made after a course has started
- If a cancellation occurs because of a visa refusal, a registration fee of €50 will be charged. In the case of a visa refusal, the refund will be

processed when the official letter of refusal from immigration is sent to IH Dublin.

- Please note that all cancellations must be sent to us in writing (by post or e-mail)

10. Refunds

No refunds can be made after a course has started. In the case of illness, students may ask for a course to be postponed to a later date. In this case the school will require a medical certificate. If a course is carried over to the next calendar year, there may be an extra fee payable.

11. Deposit and Payment

- A non-refundable deposit of 20% is required at time of booking to secure your place on the programme
- The balance of fees is due a minimum of 2 weeks before arrival

1. Age

Junior Programmes available for students aged 11-17 years old

2. Classes

Each class hour is 60 minutes. There are 15 lessons per week.

3. Fees

Package fees include:

- 15 hours tuition per week in mixed nationality classes
- Full-board Host Family or University Residential accommodation
- Afternoon activities Monday-Friday and 1 disco per week for Homestay students
- Afternoon and evening activities every day for Residential students
- 1 full day excursion per week
- All course materials, placement test and end of course certificate

4. Accommodation

Homestay Programme Cork

Accommodation is in a twin room, shared with another student of a different nationality

Residential Programme Cork

On Campus Residential accommodation in single bedrooms with shared bathroom

5. Airport Transfers

All junior students must book return transfers. We offer airport transfers from Cork Airport & Shannon Airport and also transfers from the ferry port in Cork.

If you are being accompanied by an adult/guardian on arrival or departure and you do not require transfers, please notify us in advance.

6. Insurance

Students are advised to take out private medical and travel insurance. All EU nationals should also bring a European Health Insurance Card which covers public medical care.

7. Visas

Non EU nationals should contact their local Irish Embassy or Consulate or visit the Department of Justice website www.justice.ie for details of visa requirements. IH Dublin offers an efficient visa support service.

8. Cancellation

- If a course is cancelled more than 14 days before the start date, a registration fee of €50 will be charged
- If a course is cancelled less than 14 days before the start date, one week's programme will be charged (divide 2 week course price by 2 to obtain 1 week price)
- No refunds can be made after a course has started
- If a cancellation occurs because of a visa refusal, a registration fee of €50 will be charged. In the case of a visa refusal, the refund will be processed when the official letter of refusal from immigration is sent to IH Dublin.
- Please note that all cancellations must be sent to us in writing (by post or e-mail)

9. Refunds

No refunds can be made after a course has started. In the case of illness, students may ask for a course to be postponed to a later date. In this case the school will require a medical certificate. If a course is carried over to the next calendar year, there may be an extra fee payable.

10. Deposit and Payment

- A non-refundable deposit of 20% is required at time of booking to secure your place on the programme
- The balance of fees is due a minimum of 2 weeks before arrival
