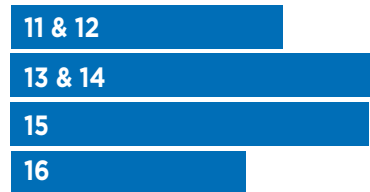

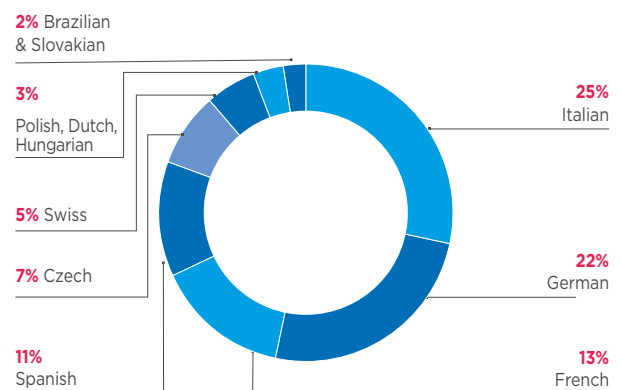

## Meet and Greet

Airport pickup is included in the package. After leaving the aircraft, students must pickup their luggage and walk through the exit, where they will see our driver who will be holding a BELS sign. Our driver will drive students to our Juniors Residence where they will be greeted by our In-House Residence Leaders who will assist them with checking-in. Thereafter they will accompany them to their room and introduce them to their new roommates.

## Student Welcome

All new arrivals have to attend our Welcome Meeting. During this meeting they will receive a welcome pack (complete with emergency phone number), school & house rules as well as a copy of the weekly programme. The welcome meeting is then followed by an orientation walk of St. Paul's Bay and Bugibba.

## Activity Programme

A number of safe and fun-filled activities (that are tailor-made for young learners) are included in our Junior Camp. All activities are supervised by our trained activity leaders, who are dedicated to making sure students have the best possible time with us.

Our accommodation is calculated on a weekly basis, 8 days/ 7 nights.

### Damage Deposit

- A cash deposit of €50 against room damages will be collected on the first day of school.
- This must be paid by all junior customers.
- The deposit is returned to the students (unless damages are done), upon their departure, at the residence.
- At the same time, students, will also receive, their course certificate.

### Insurance

Students **must** purchase a travel insurance policy to cover their journey & stay in Malta & Gozo. They can acquire their own insurance or purchase one through BELS at €12. The insurance needs to cover claims related to travel, health, injury, loss or damage of personal belongings & cancellations.

### Classes

Classes are held from Monday to Friday. We reserve the right to introduce a double banking timetable & to use classrooms in alternative premises of the same standard.

### Other Supplements

- UM (Unaccompanied Minor) service at €50 per way.
- Special diets (exc. vegetarian) €90 per week.
- Non-airport transfers (ex. Virtu' Ferry from Sicily) €60 per way.

### Accommodation details

- Accommodation is in multi-bedded rooms.
- Twin rooms (for 2 students travelling together) are available on request basis at a supplement of Eur €100 per person per week (7 nights).
- Full board includes breakfast, lunch & dinner.

- All activities are subject to sea and weather conditions. No refund will be given in cases of rough seas, bad weather, jelly fish invasion etc.
- Participants must be able to swim.
- Participants must take out a travel & water sports activities insurance policy.
- Participants who book the diving package will need to fill in a special consent form. Medical verification checks will be done locally (when needed) at an additional cost.
