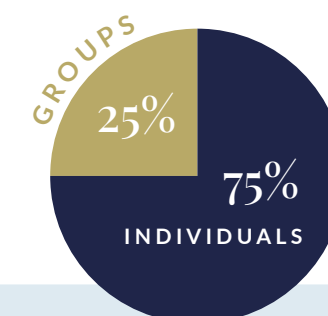
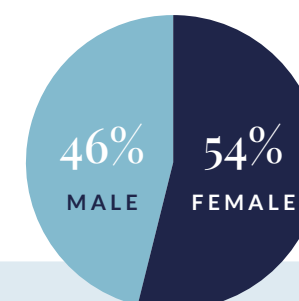

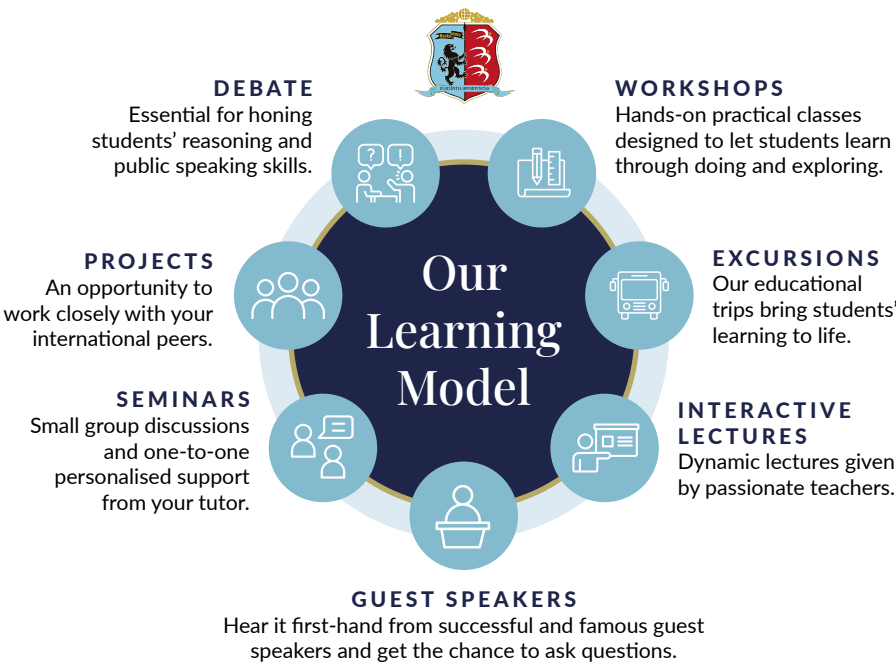

Our Learning Model

Our programmes help students build a meaningful path through school towards university or their future career.

We provide the skills, experiences and tools to support their ambitions — from small class sizes and hands-on workshops to project work, lectures and excursions. Career-focused visits and enrichment activities create a holistic learning experience that broadens horizons and strengthens every student's academic profile.



Our Timetable Explained

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

Arrivals and departures take place on Tuesdays, with complimentary transfers from three major UK airports within set hours. Students are met by a Bucksmore representative and transferred to their centre for registration. Those staying longer than one week enjoy a relaxed "Lazy Tuesday" with light activities and time for laundry.

TESTING & INDUCTION

On Wednesday, students on our English Foundation courses complete English testing and induction to ensure correct class placement, followed by a half-day excursion to Brighton, London, Oxford or Cambridge.

LESSONS & PROJECTS

Our six-tier syllabus covers all levels, focusing on speaking, listening, reading and writing, with grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation built in. Academic skills sessions introduce exam techniques and study skills, while conversation classes give space to practise English in a more relaxed way. Each week, students also complete a group project, finishing with a presentation evening — past examples include Bucksmore President and Gaming Expo.

EXCURSIONS & ACTIVITIES

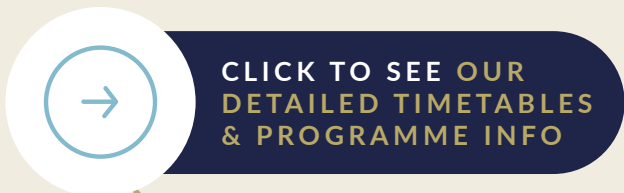
Each week includes two full-day excursions and one half-day trip to UK highlights such as Bath, Windsor and Cambridge. Our Activity Managers run varied programmes including sports, arts, crafts and themed evenings like silent discos and karaoke.

GRADUATION

Every two weeks students take part in a graduation and awards ceremony to celebrate their achievements and friendships.

EXTRAS

- » English Plus students have 7.5 hours per week of their chosen subject.
