This career-focused Medicine programme in London introduces high school students to the world of medicine, combining theoretical study, clinical practice, and medical ethics while also developing English language fluency in an academic and professional context. Leave with practical insights, a portfolio of work, and valuable preparation for future medical studies and careers.

Outside the classroom, you'll develop interpersonal skills and enjoy cultural excursions across the UK, forming new friendships and broadening your global perspective.

This subject provides a foundation in medical knowledge and practice, taught by qualified doctors and senior medical students. Each system is introduced through theory, patient history-taking, and case-based learning, before moving into practical dissections, simulations, and diagnostics. Students will explore areas such as:

- Respiratory System – anatomy, case-based scenarios, pulmonary assessments, lung dissection
- Cardiovascular System – anatomy and function, ECG basics, case simulations, heart dissection
- Nervous System – neurology assessments, imaging interpretation, brain dissection
- Urinary System – renal function, diagnostic testing, kidney dissection
- Digestive System – GI anatomy and pathologies, liver dissection
- Medical Ethics & Professionalism – principles of consent, confidentiality, end-of-life care

In addition, students take part in clinical workshops such as:

- E-Simulation Suite Day – emergency A-E assessments with Sim Man
- Surgical Skills Workshop – suturing, aseptic technique, laparoscopic dexterity tasks
