## DESTINATION : ANTIBES



With 300 days of sunshine throughout the year and 25 kilometres of sand beaches, Antibes is an exceptional destination on the French Riviera. Junior students will experience an unforgettable summer in a dynamic classroom atmosphere combined with discovery, animation, and supervision by our camp leaders.





## FRENCH COURSE

Our qualified professors offer an approach to teaching that awakens and develops the child's interest in the French language thanks to active pedagogy.

### CLASS STRUCTURE

#### Standard Course - All levels

- **20 morning lessons** of 45 minutes per week, including daily conservational workshop
- **Monday to Friday** (except the first Monday of their stay which is dedicated to the placement test)
- **15 students maximum** in a class

The 3 hours of daily **standard classes** are distributed as follows:

**2 hours of classical work:** oral and written comprehension, written and oral expression as well as grammar, pronunciation and French civilization.

**1 hour of oral activities** for a different way of learning with oral linguistic games designed to facilitate learning.

#### Intensive Course - From level A1

- **25 morning lessons** of 45 minutes per week
- **Monday to Friday** (except the first Monday of their stay which is dedicated to the placement test)
- **15 students maximum** per class

The 3h45 of daily **intensive courses** are designed for motivated students who are willing to progress faster. They offer general French instruction focused on the acquisition of oral, written and grammatical skills essential for each level. Pronunciation and French civilization also complement these skills.

### WHERE DO CLASSES TAKE PLACE?

**Summer:** Students take courses on **Campus Horticole** or **Leonardo Da Vinci**.





## FULL BOARD ACCOMMODATION

Students can choose to be accommodated in Campus or Host Family.

### ■ CAMPUS HORTICOLE

On the east side of Antibes in a quiet area and surrounded by a large garden:

- **On site:** classrooms, accommodation, a large self-service restaurant, a mobile swimming pool, and outdoor sports grounds.
- **Full Board:** breakfast, lunch and dinner (buffet style). Packed lunch at weekends.
- **Accommodation in a shared room (up to 4 students per room)**
- **Common facilities** situated on each floor (showers, sinks and toilets).

### ■ CAMPUS LEONARDO DA VINCI

In the north of Antibes, situated in a quiet and green environment:

- **On site:** classrooms, accommodation, a large self-service restaurant, a mobile swimming pool, and outdoor sports grounds.
- **Full Board:** breakfast, lunch and dinner (buffet style). Packed lunch at weekends.
- **Accommodation in shared room (3 students per room)**
- **A double sink and a shower in each room.** Common toilets on each floor.

### ■ HOST FAMILY (from 13-year-olds)

All our families are situated in Antibes/Juan les Pins.

- **Full Board:** breakfast and dinner in the host family, lunch in the restaurant of the school. Packed lunch at weekends.
- **Accommodation in a multiple room.**

## NOTES

- **On campus:**
  - **Disposable bed linen is provided** and changed weekly.
  - **A shuttle bus** is provided from the campus to the beaches and the center of Antibes.
  - **Room access is restricted** (schedule posted on site) for safety and security reasons and also to ease cleaning operations.
- **Towels are not provided** in campus, nor in host families.
- **Rooms are completely cleaned once a week.** A quick clean-up takes place during the week.
- **Students are responsible for their rooms** and must keep them clean and tidy.





## WEEKLY ACTIVITY PROGRAM

On their arrival, the students receive a welcome pack including a weekly program of activities

### 1 HALF-DAY EXCURSION/ACTIVITY:

One half day excursion/activity per week such as :

- Excursion to Cannes
- Bicycle ride
- Hiking in Cap d'Antibes

### 1 FULL-DAY EXCURSION/ACTIVITY AT THE WEEKEND

One full day excursion/activity at the weekend such as :

- Excursion to Nice
- Aquasplash or Marineland
- Excursion to Monaco
- Fragonard museum in Grasse + top tree climbing

### 1 SAILING AFTERNOON:

One weekly sailing lesson taught and run by a professional sailing school.

In case of impossibility for unforeseen reason, the sailing lesson will be replaced by paddle or kayak.

### SPORT OR WORKSHOP:

Our camp leaders also offer different games and activities for students to participate in such as: sports tournaments, dance classes, water aerobics, ping-pong, and many more!

### EVENING ENTERTAINMENT

A «barbecue» on Mondays and each evening themed meal, disco party, games, shows, etc.

## NOTES

- After the activities/excursions, students from 13 years old can have some **free time** to enjoy the city or the beach by themselves.
- At the weekend, from 2 weeks stay , all the students will participate in a full day excursion/ activity, on Saturday or on Sunday, according to the activity program. From 13 years old, the second day of the weekend will be free.
- Students accommodated in host family will spend evenings with their host family, except for the barbecue evening on Monday and for the Friday special party evening on campus..

## SECURITY AND SUPERVISION

Security 24/7. Students are supervised by our camp leaders who are on the premises round the clock and ready to help and give information.

## CURFEW RULES

### Accommodation in campus/residence

**12 years old students are not authorized** to leave the campus or go out unaccompanied.

**13 - 15 years old:** ALL students have AUTOMATIC permission to go out unaccompanied until 7.30pm maximum. NO AUTHORISATION to go out unaccompanied after 7.30 pm.

**16 - 17 years old:** ALL students have AUTOMATIC permission to leave the school unaccompanied until 7.30pm maximum. FOR THE EVENING, the parents can choose to give evening permission as below:

**Option 1:** NO evening permission unaccompanied from 7:30 pm

**Option 2:** EVENING PERMISSION as below:

Monday - Thursday till 10:00 pm\* - Fridays, Saturdays, and days prior to a bank holiday till 01:00 am - Sundays till 7.30 pm

### Accommodation in host family (from 13 years old)

**13 - 15 years old:** ALL students are allowed to leave the school unaccompanied until 7.30pm maximum  
*Except on Mondays for the mandatory barbecue party and on Fridays for the accompanied evening party till 11:00 pm*

**16 - 17 years old:** MANDATORY EVENING PERMISSION as below:

Monday - Thursday till 10:00 pm\* - Fridays, Saturdays, and days prior to a bank holiday till 01:00 am - Sundays till 7.30 pm

\* Except on Mondays until 11:00pm for the barbecue party organized on the campus.
