



JUNIOR STANDARD COURSE (8-11 y.o)

DURATION

From 1 week.

ORGANISATION

- 20 lessons (15 hours) per week.
- Monday to Friday (except on the first Monday)
- From 9:00 am to 12.20 pm (with 20 min break).
- 15 students maximum per class.

BEGINNING OF COURSES

The Monday of arrival is dedicated to a level evaluation test and a welcome meeting.

DATES

LEVEL

Elementary to B1- B2 of the CEFR (Common European Frame of Reference)

OBJECTIVES

- Acquisition of very basic grammatical skills.
- Development of practical and essential oral and written communication skills.
- To increase communication in French through very fun didactic activities adapted to a very young learners.

PROGRAMME

- Grammatical progression (20% of the course).
- Didactic activities including written and oral work with special special attention to oral practice.

METHODOLOGY

- Simulations and role plays.
- Didactic games.
- Practice outside the classroom to improve communication with native speakers and learn more about their environment (surveys, reporting in the town, etc.).
