



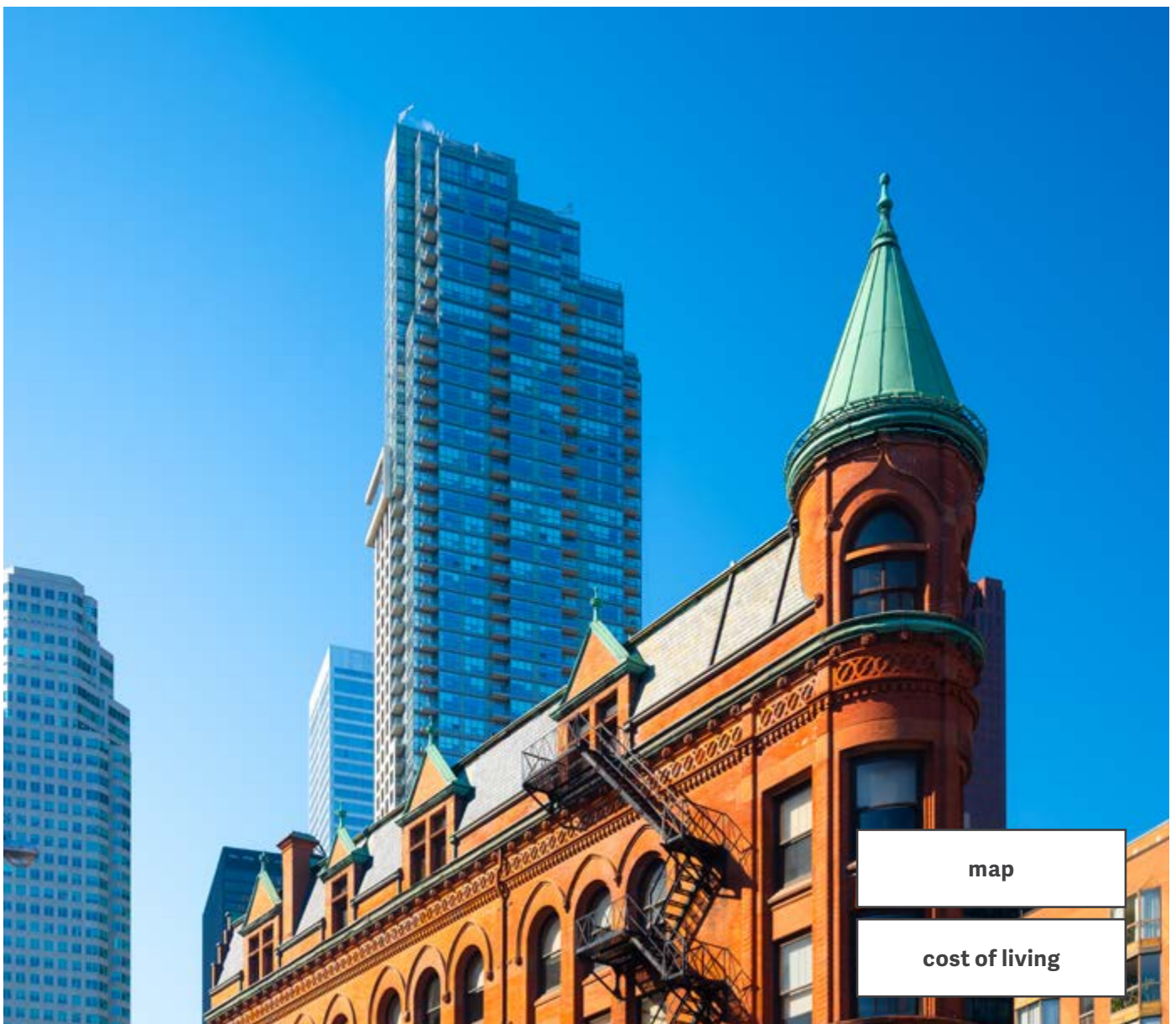
# *EC Toronto 30+*

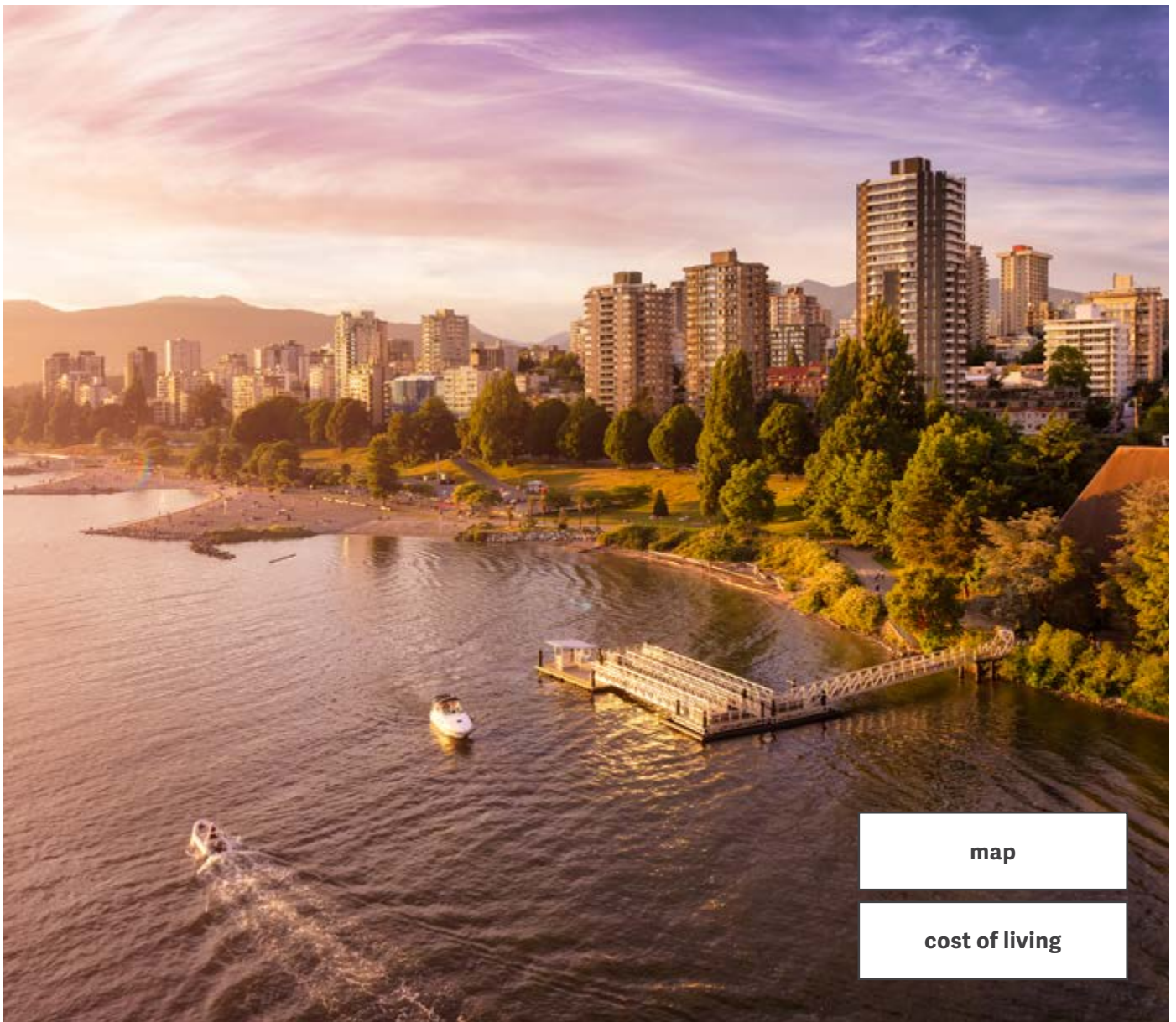
