Laundry

Cleaning

Check out

The day before you check out, your room will be inspected for any damages.

On the day of your departure please be out of your room **by 10am**.

Remember to leave the key in the key dropoff box situated at the front door entrance.







House Rules

When people are living together, everyone has to follow some rules. In respect of other guests in the house, your neighbours and the students and volunteers that will follow you, we require you obey to the house rules. Not following the house rules will have the consequences as stated below. We wish you a pleasant stay.

1. General

1.1. Smoking

1.1.1. Smoking is only permitted outside in the designated areas. Use ashtrays provided.

1.2. Tidiness

- 1.2.1. Tidy up after yourself, especially the public areas.
- 1.2.2. Wash your own dishes or use the dishwasher provided.
- 1.2.3. Throw away old food regularly.
- 1.2.4. Make use of the sanitising stations set up around the house.

1.3. Wifi

- 1.3.1. Residents of the GHS/GHV residences are allowed to use the Wifi facilities free of charge.
- 1.3.2. The service is based on fair-use basis. Excessive downloading or downloading of illegal content (i.e. pirate movies, music, software etc.) or attempting to mask your computer's identity (VPN or other spoofing software) will lead to the device(s) being blocked from our network.

1.4. Breakage

1.4.1. Any missing or broken items will be replaced by GHS/GHV. The costs will be recovered from the resident's deposit. Should no one take responsibility, the cost will be shared amongst all residents.

1.5. Turn lights off

1.5.1. Ensure lights and appliances are switched off when not in use.

1.6. Maintenance issues

1.6.1. Report maintenance issues to the school as soon as possible.

1.7. When leaving

- 1.7.1. There will be an outgoing inspection of your room prior to departure. If there are any damages or missing items you will be liable for the replacement costs.
- 1.7.2. On the day of departure, leave your keys in the key box.

2. Offences

The matters mentioned in this section are potentially dangerous and/or severely impact on your fellow residents and the neighbours.

Not respecting these rules will have the following consequences:

First time: written warning and 50% of your deposit are deducted.

Second time: written warning and the remaining 50% of your deposit are deducted.

Third time: you will be asked to leave the accommodation. No refund is given for the remaining weeks.

- 2.1. The front gate must be closed and locked at all times.
- 2.2. Excessive alcohol consumption is not allowed.
- 2.3. Keep the noise at an appropriate level. You are staying in a residential area.
- 2.4. All noisy activities must end by 21:00.
- 2.5. Parties are not permitted.
- 2.6. Smoking inside the building is strictly prohibited.
- 2.7. Only residents and a maximum of 5 invited additional GHS/GHV clients are allowed on the property. Any other people are strictly prohibited on the property.
- 2.8. Guests have to leave the residence by 21:00.
- 2.9. Keep the kitchen clean and tidy.

3. Severe Offences

The matters mentioned in this section are dangerous and must be strictly followed at all times.

If any of these rules are broken, you will be asked to leave the accommodation immediately. Your deposit will be deducted in full and no refund will be given for the remaining accommodation weeks.

- 3.1. No guests are allowed to sleep over.
- 3.2. You are not allowed to give your key to anyone.
- 3.3. Drinking of alcohol below the age of 18 is illegal in South Africa.
- 3.4. The possession, purchasing or taking of illegal narcotics is strictly prohibited.
- 3.5. The fire extinguishers and smoke alarms are there for your safety in an emergency. Tampering with this equipment is a criminal offence.
