## UPON ARRIVAL IN MALTA

Upon your arrival at the Malta International Airport after the security zone, you should look for an IELS representative holding an IELS logo sign. You will be taken by the driver to the accommodation booked.

### What to do if you can't find the driver?

## AFTER ARRIVAL

Lessons start on Monday morning.

Activities will commence immediately as per the weekly programme.

Both our Residence Supervisors & Host Families will explain your activity programme and advise the meeting point and timings.



## FIRST DAY

Students must be at IELS at 08:15 am.

You will be given your student card, and directed to your classroom. Lessons start at 08:45am. Lesson attendance is mandatory.

After the lessons, our Activity Leaders will provide the packed lunches and after a short break, students will go to their activity from IELS.



## MEALS

Breakfast, packed lunch and dinner are provided. The evening meal is usually served between 18.00 and 19.00



## SCHOOL RULES

You must:

- Attend all lessons and activities;
- Behave well;
- Carry your student ID and wear your wristband at all times.

If you miss lessons or activities, or behave badly, we may send you home immediately at your own expense.


If you cannot come to your lessons or activities because you are sick, you or your Host Family must advise the Welfare Team by calling **(+356) 9942 9617**.





## MALTESE LAW

- Do not buy, sell or use drugs;
- Do not steal;
- Do not consume alcohol or enter bars; Do not litter;
- Do not buy or carry knives, guns or other weapons;
- Do not smoke or buy cigarettes if you are under 18.



## HOST FAMILIES

The host family will wash your clothes and change your bed linen once a week. Please respect the environment you are in. Keep your room tidy, do not take food before asking and do not invite friends home without permission from your host family.



## LEISURE ACTIVITIES

On IELS's programme you will have daily morning / afternoon activities and daily evening activities.

On some days, IELS will offer optional activities too, in addition to the mandatory ones, at an extra charge.



## USEFUL INFORMATION

Tap water is safe to drink, but most people buy bottled mineral water which is available in most shops.

Electricity is 230 V, 50Hz AC. Malta has British 3-pin plugs and sockets, so you may need an adapter. Please ask your hotel or host family for help with electrical appliances.

The currency in Malta is the Euro. Many places accept credit cards, but there may be an extra charge.





## ACCOMMODATION

Students staying at IELS residence or with a host family are not allowed to leave their accommodation unsupervised at any point during their stay unless written authorisation from their parents has been provided beforehand.

Students must respect their accommodation, be neat and tidy, and ensure that they keep noise to a minimum.

If students are on a supervised activity with the IELS Malta team they may stay out later than indicated above. Please always confirm with the Activity leader responsible.
