Course description

This course is designed for more mature students and professionals wanting to improve their English in a more intensive setting with a maximum of 4 students per class.

Students learn English in the mornings and enjoy golf sessions in the afternoon included in the fees. The course content is negotiated with and guided by the teacher.

Minimum Age: 30
Maximum 4 students per class
Tuition: 15 or 19 hours
Level: All levels (beginners accepted on the first Monday of every month)

Aims and objectives

Students gain confidence in using English in a functional and practical way. Students will develop their accuracy across all the skill areas.

Progression routes

Students can opt to transfer onto one of our General English or MAX4 courses after they have completed the English plus Golf programme.
