Useful Information

Reception

The reception is open every day from 8AM to 5PM from September to May. From June to August the opening hours are from 8AM to 7PM.

Arrivals take place on Sundays from 3PM 7PM. Your apartment must be vacated before 11:00AM upon departure. Please make sure to notify **inlingua** of your time and place of arrival if you have not booked a transfer so everything is ready for you when you get there.

For arrivals after 7PM, keys to the studio will be available in the hotel's safe outside the front door. The code for this will be sent to you shortly before your arrival as it changes regularly.

Services & Facilities

24/7 Group Leader Supervision

There will always be a Group Leader from the school at the residence during your stay. This Group Leader lives on site, and is always there should you have any troubles. They will give you their number on arrival so you can always reach them if you need to.

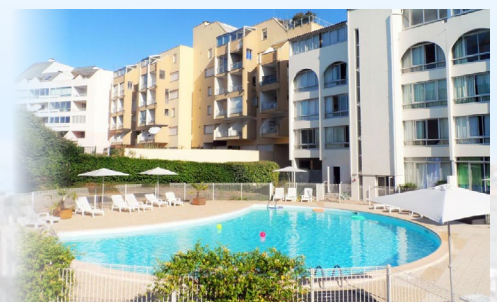
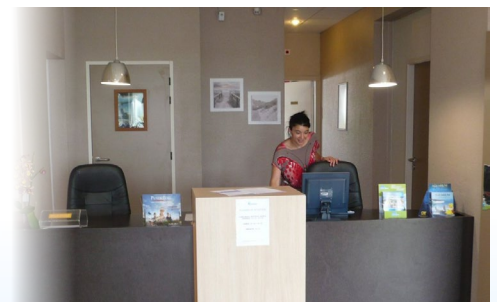
Students will be with Group Leaders throughout the afternoon activities, and for all their meals, and evenings at the residence.

Common Area

The residence offers delicious coffee, cold drinks, and snacks in the common area next to the reception from the vending machines.

The 5th floor of the residence hosts a rooftop terrace with an amazing view of the Port des Minimes and the sea as far as the eye can see! A great way to relax after a long day!

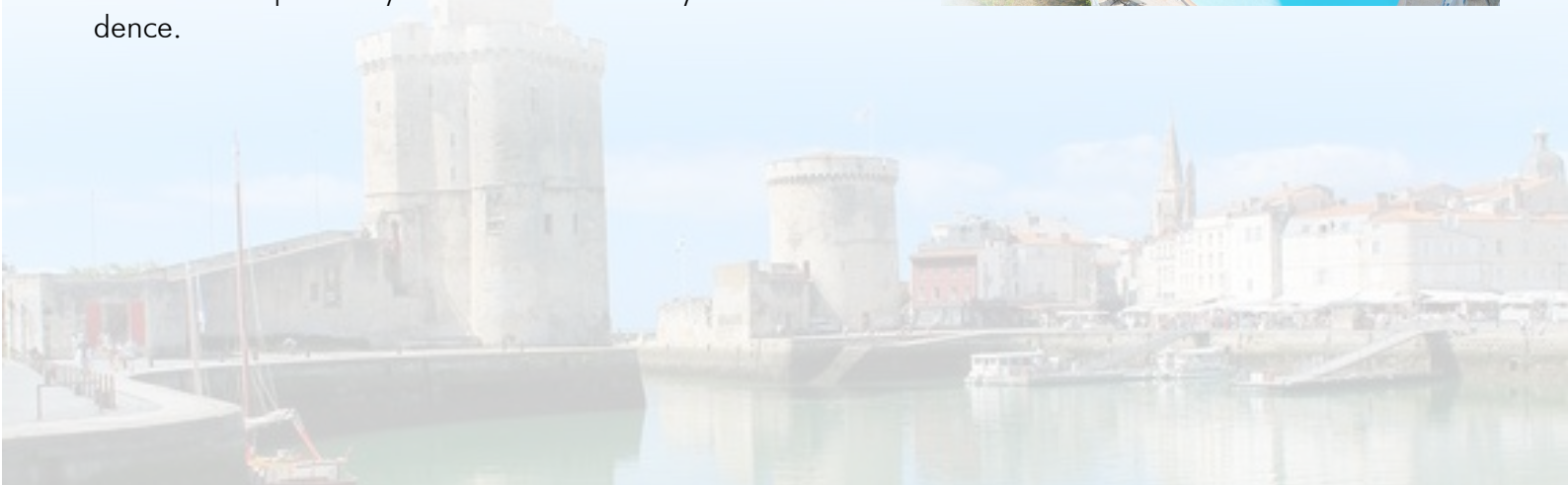
*The Wi-Fi is open access so you don't need to worry about any passwords

Arriving in La Rochelle

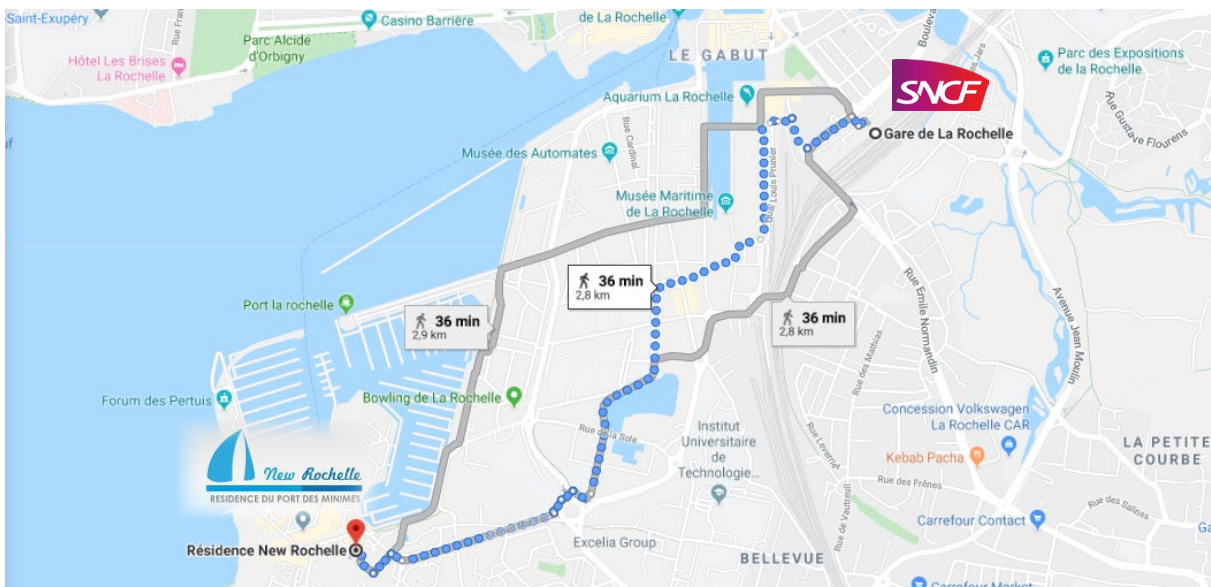
Any student arriving either at the air-port or the station on their own will automatically receive a transfer to the residence. Please make sure to notify the school of your time of arrival so somebody is there to pick you up!

For arrivals at the train station, there are several options for getting to the residence:

On Foot



It is quite a long walk to the residence from the station, but you will get to see just some of the beautiful views La Rochelle has to offer on the way. Click on the map for directions on foot

By bus

It is also possible to take a bus with either the line 3 or 4 from the bus stop Gare SNCF just next to the station, though buses do not run frequently on Sundays, and so can be more complicated than walking.

Settling In

Your Arrival

When you get to the residence, go straight to the reception to check in and get your room keys, the receptionists will explain where your room is, and how to get there. They will notify the Group Leader of your arrival who will come to help you settle in.

Once you have got to your room, have a quick check that everything is OK in there, you don't want to be blamed for breaking something that was already broken when you arrived! There is no deposit to pay for your room, but anything you might break in there during your stay will be billed.

Notify the reception if there are any problems, and make sure you go and see your Group Leader to let them know.

You will then get to meet all the other students staying at the residence, go for a swim in the pool, settle into your room, and start having fun!

There is an activity every evening for those staying in the residence, this can range from making crêpes at the school, to going into town together to enjoy the nightlife while under constant supervision.

Meals

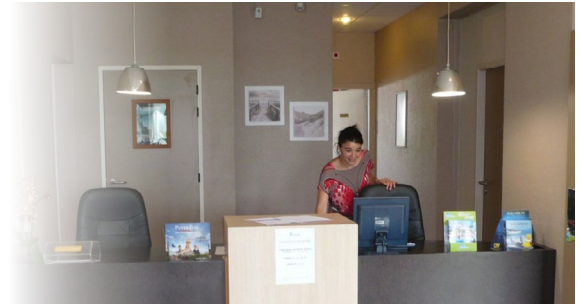
Breakfast is served either on the terrace of the residence or in the living area by the reception. A wide range of varieties are offered: coffee, tea, fruit juice, chocolate, bread/toast, ham, yoghurt, cheese and charcuterie.

For lunch, meals are had on the school's terrace. Students can enjoy salads, sandwiches, cookies, eclairs, and muffins that are delivered each day.

In the evenings, students eat at the youth hostel or one of the many surrounding restaurants only a 5-minute walk from the residence. The restaurant offers a magnificent view of the port. Several starters are offered each day. Students can choose between either eat meat or fish for their main course, with a wide range of vegetables. Cheese and dessert are also offered.

Arrivals at the residence are usually on Sundays after 3PM, the reception then remains open until 7PM. If you arrive outside of these times, there's no need to worry as the Group Leader will always be on site to check you in upon your arrival.

If you have booked a transfer, then everything will be sorted out in accordance with your time of arrival.

Getting to the school

There are several means by which our students can get from the residence to the school in the mornings.

The school is only a short walk from the residence, and students can be there in under 10 minutes (600m).

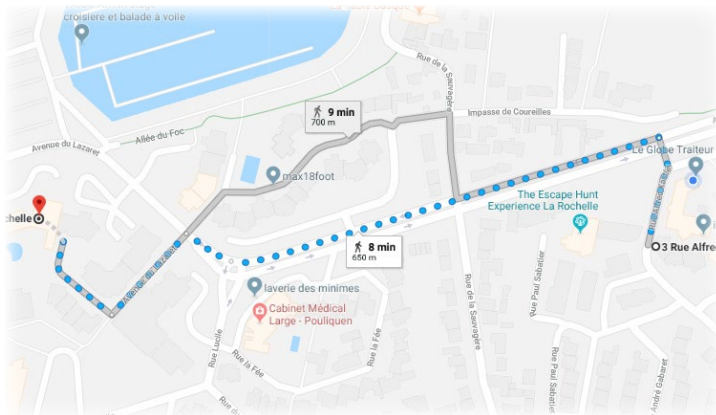
Alternatively students may take the bus to school. The nearest bus stop is only a few minutes on foot from the residence, at the bus stop '«Plage des Minimes»' which is right next to the residence.

Students can jump on line 4 and be at the school in 2 minutes.

It is probably quicker to walk to the school than to take the bus considering the distance.
