MULTIACTIVITY RESIDENCE ACCOMMODATION



General Information

Our Multiactivity Summer Camp programme enables our junior students to improve their skills in French quickly while having fun thanks to our wide array of activities and making new friends

These activities range from sailing to climbing, from visiting museums to day trips to Bordeaux, and so much more! Students taking part in this course always give us gowing feedback about their experience and a lot of them come back for more!

Every morning you will have breakfast together at the residence, and then come to the school together for classes. Your Group Leader will make sure you know where your going for any classes or activities each day.

During breakfast your Group Leader will pass round a sheet containing all the different things on offer for lunch - make sure you fill it in so you get what you want.

If the evening activities finish after the last bus, the school will provide transport back to the residence with one of our minibuses.

Excursions

inlingua organises a full-day excursion every Saturday for the Junior group, this excursion is part of your course. The details of the trip will be on display at the school every week. Students staying at the residence will go and return with the group leader for any activity or excursion.

Timetable

On the first morning, students are asked to come to the school at 8:30. This is so we may organise a quick interview with new students to check that each person is placed into the correct group.

During lunch the students can sit outide in the sun together and enjoy whatever they have chosen, but don't stray far as activities start before 2 (including transport time).

During the afternoons the Group Leaders will take you to various places around La Rochelle for fun and exciting activities. They will tell you if you need to bring something specific, just make sure to wear trainers!

After activities you will all go back to the residence together to have a shower and prepare for dinner. Dinner is normally had at one of the restaurants around Les Minimes, but is occasionally a meal at the school with the other students.

It is possible to sign up to the Exam Prep version of this programme too. In this case Wednesday and Friday afternoon activities will be replaced by exam workshops. It is also possible to add an additional 5 hours of one-to-one classes to this course which takes 1 hour per day before afternoon activities.
