Lesson programme

Students will have 1.5 hours per day of English lessons, including a variety of content designed to build speaking confidence and increase British culture awareness.

Students will also benefit from an extra daily 45 minutes of Soft Skills. Built around the location, these are designed to improve communication, listening, teamwork and interpersonal skills

Excursion programme

Our exciting programme will include one full day and one half day trip each week

Full day:

- Rome with various different tours, including the Vatican, Ancient Rome, and walking, churches and fountains tours
- Maremma Nature Park
- Pitigliano historic town. Also known as Little Jerusalem and includes a relaxing thermal bath
- Cerveteri waterfall

Half day:

- Civita di Bagnoregio, where 2 earthquakes took place — see the ruins of the old city as well as the modern new city
- Bolsena: with a medieval fortress, a Renaissance palace and the *Miracle Chapel*
- Viterbo: also known as the *City of the Popes* and the *City of Thermal Baths*
- Romitori del Fiora: with rooms carved into the rock, made to host the hermits.
 Including a refreshing swim in the river!









Accommodation

- Students will reside in purpose-built 'cottages'. There are 2 twin bedded rooms per cottage, each with a bathroom (ratio 1 bathroom: 2 students). 2 cottages share a comfortable veranda with table and chairs
- All cottages are air conditioned. Boys and girls will be housed in separate cottages.
 Please note a deposit of 50 EURO per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Towels are not included.

Meal plan

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day. Lunch and dinner are usually hot (with packed lunches on excursion days) and there is usually a choice of at least two main courses. We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on request.
- Bottled water is also supplied to students
