### Conservation

Work alongside our project partners in Scotland's rainforest and ancient woodlands helping to conserve and restore these vulnerable environments. Take part in nature conservation activities in remote locations which include supporting the removal of invasive species, restoration, rewilding green spaces, tree planting, habitat and wildlife monitoring, and trail maintenance.



### Campaigning

Equip yourself with skills to become a climate activist, and learn about sustainability, and environmental action in the UK. Our lesson plan includes, Climate Justice, Conservation, Behaviour Change, and Campaigning and Advocacy. Following your participation, you can mobilise yourself and others to take action by joining our climate campaign, Action Not Excuses.

### Remote leadership trek

Take on some of Scotland's most challenging but beautiful terrains on an 11-day remote leadership trek. Venture off the beaten track and set up a new wild camp every night alongside your team of fellow volunteers. You will learn essential skills in leadership, teamwork, planning, problem-solving, and resilience.
