





Unaccompanied Minor (UM) Service

Should parents opt in for the UM service through their airline, a designated Samiad staff member will be responsible for completing the paperwork for the student upon both arrival and departure. An additional administrative fee of $\pounds 40$ (each way) is charged for this service. This must be arranged in advance.

Visas and Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA)
