A SUMMER SCHOOL BUILT AROUND YOU

With a minimum of 15 hours of formal English lessons each week, pupils are placed onto the Junior (Ages 8-11) or Senior Course (Ages 12-16). All Sedbergh teaching staff are experienced, enthusiastic native level speakers. Our 1:15 teacher-pupil ratio ensures pupils benefit from their teacher's dedicated time and attention.

Formal lessons are timetabled on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday mornings. (Thursdays and Sundays are excursion days). Active Communication is encouraged throughout the course and language skills continue to develop as our pupils take part in a wide and varied range of excursions and activities. Speaking, listening and reading skills are continually assessed and improved alongside their general comprehension and understanding of English grammar.

During lessons, students are divided into groups by age and ability, based on their placement test results. Lessons are tailored to the needs of the group, thus maximising pupil engagement, enjoyment and language development.

Every student receives a full academic report and certificate at the end of the course with comments from their Teacher, Houseparent and the Course Director.

The Right Level For You

Pupils will complete a short online placement test in advance of the course, the results of which enable teachers to allocate them to the most appropriate class for their ability.

LIRA is a transformative, 2-week development programme for 14-16 year olds.

Leadership develops through a combination of knowledge, tools and experience.

Designed as a progressive curriculum that continuously stretches the pupils in a supportive and encouraging environment, LIRA enables young people to learn, explore and practice the foundations of how to lead themselves and others through a combination of personal coaching, experiential learning and fun excursions.

Programme content is delivered using in-person priming sessions followed by individual and group exercises, all of which focus and relate back to our four themes: leading; caring; connecting and exploring.

LIRA is run by a team of subject matter experts more usually found working within the corporate environment. Week one focuses on leadership skills acquisition which are then put into practice over the weekend in a 'real life simulation' experience. Week two allows students to explore global challenges, applying their newly acquired skills to lead change.

OUR LOCATION

Sedbergh International Summer School is uniquely placed within the heart of Northern England. The Summer School occupies both Sedbergh School and Sedbergh Preparatory School campuses with the first two weeks (6-20 July 2024) held in Sedbergh. The second half of the programme (20 July - 10 August) is held at Sedbergh Preparatory School which is located a short 15 minute drive from Sedbergh in Casterton, on the outskirts of the attractive Cumbrian town of Kirkby Lonsdale.

Sedbergh and Casterton both benefit from excellent road and rail links. Manchester International Airport is within easy distance and Oxenholme Lake District railway station can be reached from London Euston in 2 hours 40 minutes via regular direct trains.

ESCORTED ARRIVALS AND TRANSFERS

BY AIR

Pupils will be met on arrival at the airport by a member of staff. Once within our care, pupils will be provided with refreshments before being transferred from the airport to Sedbergh or Casterton via our fleet of minibuses or via transport arranged by our in-house transport department.

Escorted shared transfers are provided at no additional cost when arriving on the designated arrival and departure dates from Manchester and Liverpool airports. Transfers outside these times and from other airports can be arranged at an additional cost.

BY RAIL

Oxenholme Lake District station can be reached by direct train from the following cities:

- Manchester: 1 hour 20 mins.
- London: 2 hours 40 mins
- Glasgow: 1 hour 40 mins
